We encourage all volunteers to be part of a regular schedule determined with the volunteer coordinator.

Can I bring a group or team to volunteer?

We welcome corporate teams, schools, service groups and church group participation. Groups need to be scheduled in advance.

Can I get school community service hours?

Yes. Please plan to fill out a student volunteer application form and we will help you arrange an orientation session.

What should I wear?

The dress code at the food bank is casual and comfortable.

What if I have allergies?

The food bank is not a peanut free environment. Know your allergies and medical needs. You are responsible for your medical needs.

Interested in Volunteering?

Please drop by the Food Bank to pick up a volunteer application form and an OPP criminal background check. The OPP will complete the background check at no cost to you.

Next, bring us the completed application form and background check. Your application will be reviewed and, if approved, you will be asked to sign a declaration of confidentiality.

All new volunteers will take part in an orientation program and become a volunteer on our monthly schedules.

Food Sorting

To sorting food donations into different categories, repackaging when necessary, and checking for expiry dates.

To pick up weekly donations from local stores.
